

## **CHILD ABUSE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

### **CONTACTING THE COUNCIL**

The Boy Scouts require immediate notification of a Scout Executive whenever information about possible child abuse in the Boy Scout program is uncovered. The current policy for after-hours notification is to wait until the next business day and call the Scout office in Racine at (262) 632-1655 or 1-800-773-1655.

The Scout Executive will ensure that all state reporting requirements have been met and will also take measures to protect the youth in the Scouting movement.

If an immediate report is to be made due to extreme emergency, a contact to Children & Family Services Division should be made. In Racine County, the number is (262) 638-6353 and in Kenosha County, the number is (262) 605-6582.
