

# Camp/Erin

Nestled in the scenic Kettle Moraine forest, Camp/Erin offers 324 acres of pine-laden woods and rolling prairie. It is an ideal location to promote recreational and educational activities consistent with the mission and goals of the Milwaukee County Boy Scouts. Camp/Erin offers exclusive use of the facilities to the Milwaukee County Boy Scouts up to six weekends a year. The camp is located on Highway Q, just east of Highway 83, in the Town of Erin, Wisconsin.

#### Available Activities

*Camping* - More than 30 beautiful campsites, each equipped with a picnic table and fire ring

*Bicycling, hiking & cross-country skiing* - These activities share the same marked trails throughout Camp/Erin's woods and prairies. Cross-country skiing is permitted when there is a snow cover of at least seven inches.

*Fishing* - A small, scenic pond offers catch and release fishing. A license is required of anyone age 16 and older.

*Orienteering* - Grab a compass and, with the help of a topographical map, set out to discover the more than two dozen markers strategically placed throughout the camp.

*Wildlife Tracking* - Watch for turkeys, deer, rabbits, chipmunks, squirrels, and countless bird species.

#### Amenities

The pavilion, accommodating up to 50 people, is an ideal location for Boy Scout gatherings and group activities.

Access to water wells and bathroom facilities.



#### Reservations and Hours

The Milwaukee County Boy Scouts are allowed to use Camp/Erin during the following weekends:

- fourth weekend in January
- third weekend in April
- one weekend in June\*
- one weekend in July\*
- third weekend in September
- second weekend in October

\*June and July are subject to mutual agreement no later than one year in advance. Reservations can be made through the Milwaukee County Council Boy Scout Camping Department at 414-443-2843.

#### Regulations

- No commercial activity (any activity which generates income) or soliciting activity (i.e., fundraisers or group memberships) is permitted.
- No smoking, tobacco use, fireworks, or firearms are allowed on the property.
- No unlawful activity is permitted (including, but not limited to underage drinking, or possession or use of illegal drugs).
- No ATVs, snowmobiles, motorized bikes, hunting or paintball activities are allowed.
- No campfires can be built except in designated fire pits. All fires/ coals must be extinguished completely before any visitor leaves the area. Any fire ban must be observed.
