

NESA Honor Patrol Sequence

(As soon as the Eagle Scout Board of Review is completed)

1. Scoutmaster, Parents or Scout contacts NESA Honor Patrol District Representative for a NESA Honor Patrol at their Eagle Scout Court of Honor.
2. NESA District Representative explains NESA Memberships that are available and how to register for membership.
3. NESA Rep asks for full name of Eagle Scout as he would like it to appear on the Three Harbors Council NESA Committee Certificate.
4. NESA Rep asks for a firm date and location for the Eagle Scout Court of Honor.

(Once Date and location are known, the District Honor Patrol Rep asks one or two members of the District NESA Honor Patrol to confirm participation in the Eagle Scout Court of Honor. After establishing a commitment from the NESA Honor Patrol Members, a contact is made to the person who is completing the preparations for the new Eagle Scouts' Court of Honor. The following information is then shared with the contact person.)

- 1 A confirmation of the total cost for the NESA Neckerchief and Eagle Slide is given to the Scoutmaster,

Parents or sponsor. Information is then supplied that the purchase of these items and readying them for the presentation will be taken care of by the NESAs Honor Patrol with reimbursement for items purchased to be given to the NESAs Honor Patrol after the Ceremony.

- 2 A copy of The NESAs Honor Patrol presentation will be supplied to the person responsible for the ceremony prior to the ceremony, this avoids any duplication of all the presentations in the overall ceremony. The Three Harbors Council NESAs Certificate will be supplied at the same time, to allow for framing, if the person responsible for the Court of Honor, so chooses.

(This concludes the responsibilities of the NESAs District Honor Patrol person with the following to be completed by the person responsible for the Eagle Scout Court of Honor)

- 1 After receiving the NESAs Membership Card, Membership pin, and NESAs Certificate. The Three Harbors Council NESAs Committee Certificate and All of the above are held by the person responsible and brought to the ceremony for presentation by the NESAs Honor Patrol to the Eagle Scout and new NESAs Member in the ceremony. (With all items in place a successful NESAs Honor Patrol will take place!)
