First off I would like to explain that NESAs stands for The National Eagle Scout Association. This group was founded in May of 1972, but let me further add that this was a merger with The National Chapter of the Knights of Dunamis. This organization began in 1925 with 10 Eagle Scouts to form an association that would retain the dignity of the Eagle Scout Award and provide a base for continuing leadership in the scouting movement. As noble as that was, their principle goal was service and that is what The Three Harbors NESAs Committee is focused on today.

Our Committee has developed a NESAs Honor Patrol. What they offer to this district, is a group of NESAs Members making a presentation at your next Eagle Scout Court of Honor. This presentation is offered by two or three NESAs Members. We will come to your new Eagles Court of Honor or other ceremony your Troop sets up to honor your Eagle Scout. Our presentation is approximately 10 minutes in duration and we will work with you on the proper time for our presentation. We will supply our

presentation document prior to your Eagle Court of Honor, this will allow for proper planning and the avoidance of duplication. We stress that a continuation in the scouting program is a lifelong commitment. We represent NESAs with the wearing of the signature NESAs Neckerchief and Eagle Slide. Our Three Harbors NESAs Members are from different occupations and some are still members of the Scouting Society. We dress representing these occupations and all members wear the NESAs Neckerchief and Eagle Slide. These items are a distinct notification that we all are part of the NESAs Brotherhood that we are welcoming your new Eagle into.

What we expect from you:

- Notification of your event as soon as your' new Eagle is planning his Court of Honor.
- Enroll your new Eagle in NESAs. (During our ceremony, we will present his NESAs Certificate, NESAs Wallet Card, NESAs Lapel Pin and his Three Harbors Council NESAs Committee Certificate).
- Reimbursement for the NESAs Neckerchief and Eagle Slide. (We purchase and prepare these items. We then present his NESAs Neckerchief and Eagle Slide during the ceremony).

The benefits of their NESAs Membership are many. To list some, scholarships, net working with the Three Harbors NESAs

Committee through after 5 events as well as all NESAs Members through their member web site.

Membership is easy through the NESAs web site.

- If your new Eagle is within 6 months of his Board of Review, A membership is available for \$20. This is good through his 23rd birthday.
- A \$35 5 year membership is also available. (This can be applied to a lifetime membership when it expires)
- A lifetime Membership is available for \$250 dollars—best value!
- The NESAs Neckerchief is item 64080 and the cost is \$14.99
- The Eagle Slide is item 14019 and the cost is \$11.99 (Slide has a spot on the back for engraving. A real keepsake!)
- His full name as you would like it to appear on his Three Harbors Council NESAs Committee Certificate.

In past presentations, Troops have given these items as a gift to their new Eagle Scout or parents have stepped forward to make this gift to their son.

Please apply for the NESAs Membership following his Board of Review. The NESAs Items will be sent out quickly and you will have plenty of time for framing his NESAs Certificate.

When we supply the Presentation Ceremony Document prior to your Court of Honor, We will also supply his Three Harbors NESAs Committee Certificate for framing, if you so choose.

The Neckerchief and Slide will be picked up by us for the presentation with your reimbursement following.

We have done many ceremonies to date and all have been well received! Can we do yours?
